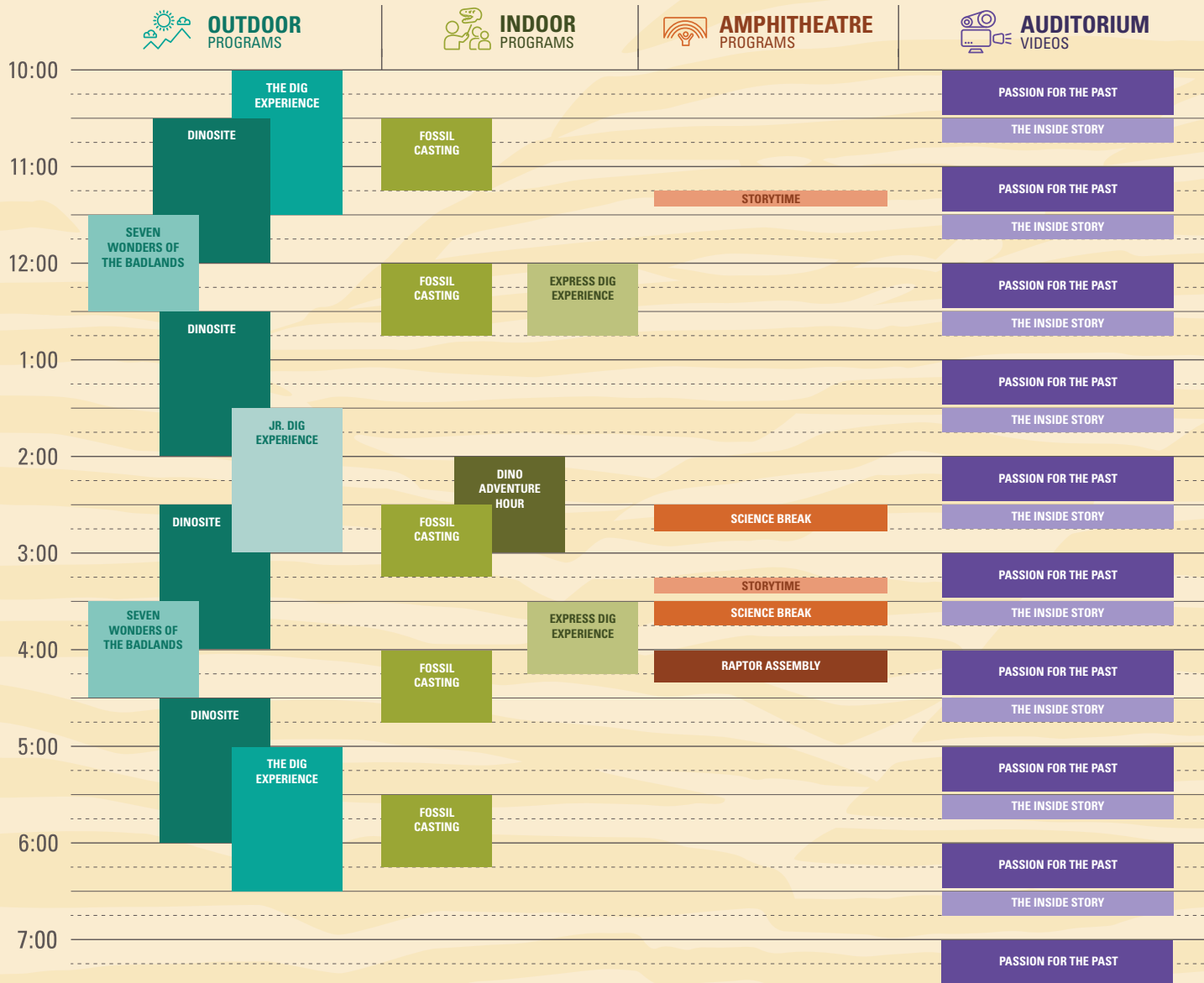

Ages 6+ | 45 minutes | \$10/person  
Use palaeontological tools to uncover real fossils indoors.

### DINO ADVENTURE HOUR

Ages 3 – 6 | 60 minutes | \$10/child  
Watch as your kids learn, dig, and create (adult required).
